

SecureGuard[®] Dashboard Quick Setup Guide

Speco's SecureGuard[®] Dashboard solution is a browser based interface that lets you manage and monitor all of your devices. This guide will help you get started with adding a recorder site and configuring it to send notifications to your dashboard.



Logging into SecureGuard® Dashboard

Access SecureGuard[®] Dashboard on any web browser on your Windows or Mac PC as well as mobile web browser.

In the web address box of your web browser, enter https://specodash.cloud, press the "Enter" key and click "Login".

Enter your e-mail and password. Then click "Log In".

Customizing SecureGuard® Dashboard

Customize the Dashboard with your company information.

In your dashboard interface, first click the gear icon on the dashboard, and then click "Settings".

Adding an Account

Create Accounts to organize your recorder sites. For example, "Chipotle[®]" or "McDonalds[®]" would identify as an account.

In the dashboard interface, click the top tree level of the dashboard, which is the Installer company name, and then click "**Add Account**".

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Enter the name of the account (mandatory information will have a * next to it) and click "Save".



The new customer account will be shown as a child tree under the company name.



Adding Sublevels to an Account

If the Account is a chain with multiple locations, multiple sublevels (as many as needed) can be added to organize their location hierarchy and/or devices.

To add a sublevel to an Account, click the Account that needs a sub-level and click "Add SubLevel".

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Adding and Managing Dashboard Users

Adding Dashboard Users will allow others to log into the dashboard with permissions based on their User type.

Admin Users will have the same permissions as the main dashboard Admin and have access to all accounts.

Advanced Users and Users will have limited permissions and can be assigned to view specific accounts assigned by Admins.

Below is a breakdown of the 3 User types and their permissions:

Adding and Managing the Installer Team

This Dashboard feature allows the creation of individual login credentials for the members of the installer team. Once created, the installer team member will register their credentials on our SecureGuard[®] Client Mobile App (available for iOS and Android).

Once registered, they can add Speco Blue Recorders to the dashboard using their phone once the recorder has been connected to the internet.

Mobile data or Wi-Fi connection required.

Adding Installers

When logged into your dashboard, click "Installers".

- Select the level it will be assigned under
- Click "Save"

How the Installer Registers on the SecureGuard® Client Mobile App

You will want to instruct your installers to register their assigned credentials created on the dashboard (Review Chapter) on the SecureGuard[®] Client Mobile App for iOS[®] and Android[™].

Once registered, they will use the SecureGuard[®] Client Mobile App to scan the QR code of the recorders to add and send them to your dashboard for assignment.

They will first need to download the SecureGuard[®] Client Mobile App from the App Store or Google Play Store.

First-Time Setup for SecureGuard® Client App

1. When users open the SecureGuard[®] Client app for the first time, they will be prompted to add a device. They should tap "Cancel" to skip this step.





How the Installer Registers on the SecureGuard® Client Mobile App (continued)

2. The installer may be prompted to allow access to their microphone which is for utilizing the two-way audio feature in the app. Proceed with the selection to continue.



3. On the main screen, they will press the Hamburger menu.



4. Press "About".



5. Press the SecureGuard[®] Shield 7 times which will then display "Installer Options Enabled"



How the Installer Registers on the SecureGuard[®] Client Mobile App (continued)

6. Press the " < " icon



7. The installer will be asked to allow the application to use their location. Make the selection to proceed.



8. Press the hamburger menu again.



9. Press "Installer Setup". This is where they will enter their login credentials to register their device to send recorders to the dashboard.

10. The installer will then enter their login credentials and press "Register".

If successful, the Registration Status will change to "Registered" and a message will display below stating "Device successfully registered." Press "Close.

Managing Installer Team

To make any changes to the installer team or check their login credentials, follow the steps below.

View or Change an Installer's Password

In the event an installer forgets their password or wants to have their password changed, locate the installer on the table and click the edit icon found under the "Actions" column.

View the installer's current password by clicking the eye icon next to the hidden password. If the password needs to be changed, simply enter a new password and click '**Save**'. To cancel any changes, click '**Close**'.

Configuring Recorder to Send Notifications to Dashboard

After adding a recorder to the dashboard, configure it to send notifications to the dashboard when a tampering or channel loss event occurs. These notifications will be displayed on the main page when logged in.

This configuration can be done at the recorder or through its web setup under E-mail in its Network setting. Enter the following information below. Once completed, click "**Apply**" and click "**Edit Recipient**".
